What Do You Want to be When you Grow Up?

In a recent sermon I shared a story of a conversation I had with a parent of one of our former preschoolers who is now in high school. The conversation was about this anxiety the student was going through regarding what they're going to focus on in college. Do any of you remember that pressure? I remember the idea that I would need to make that decision in high school before even applying to college. When I did get to college, we had to do orientation, and I remember the kids that had already declared their major got to go to orientation and register for classes before kids like me, who hadn't declared yet. It didn't seem fair, especially, when I did go to register and a lot of classes were already full.

I kind of marvel at how much we're told we need to make decisions about who we are and what we're going to do for the rest of our lives, both at a young age, and just in general. Wouldn't it be amazing if we celebrated people who know what they're passionate about and know what they want to pursue early on as well as those who just want to take a journey of discovery? What if we also celebrated the idea of not knowing? Or the idea that human growth is multifaceted and not just a linear progression?

When I was getting ready to interview at Bethania, the paperwork Bethania had to fill out ahead of time kept referencing this guy named Grundtvig over and over again and so to prepare for my interview I figured I should look up who he is and what he's about. Thank God, because it not only helped me out in the interview, but I loved what I discovered. A school model that focuses on learning for life, discovering and utilizing passion, and learning for the betterment of the community? What a novel (not really novel) idea.

I share all this to say, I think the world would be better if we approached each day from a place of discovery, or a journey, a place where we expect growth in one another instead consistency. What if we were given the grace to change our minds or given the expectation that who we were five years ago might not be who we are right now. Would we be gentler with one another? More understanding in moments of conflict? When we talk about God's grace, I imagine this is how God approaches each of us. I don't think God expects us to have life figured out at 18 any more than God expects us to have life figured out at 65.

I imagine God might see us in moments of agony or distress or frustration, and knows this is only a reflection of a point in our lives and growth and evolution is a given. Heck, I'd even wager that part of the reason many folks don't change or grow is because we lump people into categories of "that's just how they'll always be," and we might be more courageous in admitting faults if given the grace to change. Maybe this all starts with encouraging our youth into spaces of discovery, rather than spaces of needing to figure it out.

We need bags for our Food Distribution program. Weekly, we use 200 brown paper grocery bags & 200 heavier-duty plastic for produce. Please drop them off in the boxes in the narthex.

Blessing Box Items Needed

The use of the **Blessing Box** in front of our church has been a huge eye-opener as to how many in our valley are living on the edge. If you or someone you know is in need, please be aware that food is available at Bethania in the Blessing Box 24/7 as well as at our USDA Tuesday Food Distribution, which is held from 5:15-6:45 each Tuesday.

Whatever you use in your home – that is what we need for the Blessing Box! Items needed for the Blessing Box include canned and dried foods, snacks, cereal, coffee, condiments, cleaning supplies (such as dish soap, laundry soap, toilet bowl cleaners), cooking oil, personal care items, meal kits, tuna, chicken, mac & cheese...you get the idea. We have even been blessed with produce from local gardeners, home canned jam and sweets from Albertson's.

Feel free to put your items (that do not require refrigeration) straight into the box on the Atterdag Road side of the church. THANK YOU to all who have contributed items, donated, and helped to keep this project going. Our goal with the Blessing Box was to have anyone in the community be able to access assistance at any time, without any stigma, from the items within it. Special thanks to Elizabeth Breen, Donna Hinsbeeck, Carolyn Schuit, Kristyl Downey and Rick Marzullo, Scarlett, Jan and Bill Zigler and many others who are all assisting in keeping our "mighty pantry on a post" filled for people who need it.

You can also contact us for a day/time to sign up to help check the box – or just make a point of stopping by at a time good for you to see that it is filled. Thank you to all who already do this!

Currently we are serving over 800 Solvang residents weekly with food, items for the elderly (incontinence, Ensure) and infants (formula, baby food). We provide food to SYV residents who are struggling with food insecurity due to low paying jobs and high rents – these are the people who help to keep our town and area running.

The "Noisy Sunday" offering will be used to purchase diapers, diaper rash cream, powdered formula and baby food to give out at our weekly food distribution. Consider this another way to honor the mothers around us!

These items help struggling families keep their babies healthy, clean, fed and nurtured. For many of these families, finding funds to purchase diapers and formula are a struggle. Depending on which style of diaper, a good range to estimate for a monthly disposable diaper budget is between \$150-275 per month. The average monthly cost for powdered formula for babies is \$400 to \$800. Specialty formulas, such as those that contain hydrolyzed proteins, may cost even more.

We all really "make change for the better" with the Noisy Offering! So bring your coins and make some noise to help celebrate mothers and their hard but rewarding work. Together, we can CHANGE a mother's – and a child's - world!


