As I think of the year coming up I have to tell you I'm excited and I want to share with everyone all the great things happening at Bethania as we enter this program year. Before I do, I also want to say, I know the world feels crazy, and there are plenty of outlets that make the world feel even more chaotic. I believe physical community and living out our values will always be the balm to that chaos and a reminder that we can create change.

I hope you all can join us for Kick-Off Sunday and our End-of-Summer BBQ on September 7th. I would love folks to prioritize coming to church in person, to fill the space up, and remember how good it feels to be with our community in worship. We now have a really fun Children's Lesson where the "big kid" in me gets to come out and the children say the funniest things, while learning about the love of God. To emphasize the importance of children in our community, we're also starting a 2nd Sunday School class during the 9:30 service, where kids will get to do crafts, play games, and learn even more about God's love!

Our End-of-Summer BBQ will be after the worship service and have its usual features of burgers, dogs, sides, drinks, music, games, a bounce-house, and lots of fun while we share all the ways people can be involved at Bethania! Later on in the evening, our Youth Group will gather for the first Sunday of the year. Kids in grades 6-12 are invited to come and share a meal, play games, develop a sense of community with each other, and learn about Jesus and this way of life of love and compassion we're called to. Youth Group has been growing the last couple of years and I'm so thrilled to share that we have 32 kids signed up this year!

The following Sunday, we'll gather once again for our annual Day of Service, led by Linda Marzullo and our amazing Social Ministry committee where we will pack Personal Care Kits and School Kits to be shipped out to where they're needed most. Our Social Ministry team has been doing an incredible job keeping our community connected to our call to love our neighbors, especially those who need it most.

And all that is just the start! This Fall alone we'll also have our Danish Days Organ Concert on 9/20, Danish Days Float Decorating on 9/19 for the parade on 9/20, Bible Gift Sunday on 9/28, the Fall Camping Trip 10/10-10/12, Blessing of the Quilts sometime in October, the Halloween Party on 10/25, Fall Potluck on 11/9, and Interfaith Thanksgiving on 11/24. Whew!

We have always been a busy church, but this year it feels like there's something in the air. Something big is happening at Bethania. We're growing and we're thriving and it's exciting! I'm so grateful for what's happening and the joy being experienced by our community. We have a lot coming up this Fall and I hope to see you there!

Danish Days Organ Concert

Favorite festival organist James Welch is "Bach" by popular demand for this year's Danish Days celebration, playing on the authentic pipe organ at Bethania. A world-renowned concert organist, Welch's concerts are always full of fun with something for everyone — from the baroque to the contemporary, from the Old World to California. A direct descendant of Danes from Fjenneslev, Denmark (his grandmother was a *Sorensen*), he credits his Danish ancestors with his love for music. The Danish Days concert will demonstrate the lighter side of the organ, with folk tunes and some hits from opera and Broadway. And yes, there will be some Bach, too! Get there early, because this event is often a standing-room-only affair. (*suggested \$5.00 donation for concert*)

Food Distribution and Blessing Box Continue to be needed

Bethania is a Food Distribution site Tuesdays from 5:15-6:45 pm. Distribution is through the drive up or walk up lines. We serve people from all walks of life from teenagers up to our oldest who is now 95 years old. The average number of households being served is 250. You can make a difference!

Anything you use in your own home is something that can be donated and appreciated by someone else who can't afford it! We can use items in the Blessing Box or for Tuesday's Distribution. Donations can be left in the church, in the Blessing Box, or you can contact me to drop off items. On Tuesdays we also distribute baby formula, donated diapers and wipes, along with incontinence and feminine hygiene items. Donations are appreciated in these areas also.

If you would like to help please contact me. We value every volunteer assisting us and cannot thank them enough. Tuesdays are split into shifts: packing the bags at 9 am except the last week of the month when we pack in the afternoon; unloading Food Bank truck around 1:15ish and packing produce; distribution helpers coming around 4:45 for the evening shift; and cleaning up at the end of the night.

We continue to need your prayers and support for this mission, which is making a difference in so many lives here in our area.

Noisy Sunday Sept. 28 - Make Change for the Better

The offering from that day will be used to help cover the shipping costs of both the Personal Care Kits and the School Kits that we will be sending to the Lutheran World Relief Warehouse. This offering helps Lutheran World Relief ship the kits to the people who need them. We send our kits to an "ingathering" day set up by LWR, so that there is no cost to us to ship them to the warehouse.

Why do we need to ask for shipping cost donations instead of using those funds for creating more kits? Here's why: We plan to make 120+ School Kits and 175+ Personal Care Kits. According to LWR, the approximate processing and shipping cost for each kit is as follows:

LWR Mission Quilt: (per quilt \$2.25) LWR School Kit: (\$1.40 per kit)

LWR Personal Care Kit: (\$2.65 per kit)*

*Your gifts to the LWR Quilt & Kit Shipping Fund, for Personal Care Kits, also helps LWR cover the cost of providing a tube of toothpaste for each kit

Your quarters, dimes and nickels (and hopefully some dollars!) will help us ship both types of kits, which are desperately needed, according to LWR.
